New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG", or the "Company") hereby submits for filing the enclosed Addendum to its SC-14 Tariff in compliance with the Order in Case No. 93-M-0990, dated June 2, 1994.

Addendum No. 2 to SC-14 of PSC No. 120 - Electricity

Effective April 18, 2004

The section on Confidentiality and Trade Secrets of the SC-14 Tariff in its Original Leaf No. 77 of PSC No. 115, issued on November 8, 1993 and effective June 7, 1994, states... "information furnished by the Customer and required to be submitted to the New York State Public Service Commission shall not be submitted without a request by NYSEG that such information shall be given trade secret protection in accordance with 16 NYCRR, 6-1.3. When any such information is required to be submitted to the New York State Public Service Commission, NYSEG will notify the customer of such request prior to its submittal."

Pursuant to the aforementioned section, NYSEG is concurrently submitting a request to the Records Access Officer of the State of New York Department of Public Service for trade secret protection for the information concealed in the enclosed addendum. NYSEG has already notified its Customers of its intention to request trade secret protection for a limited set of data from their respective contractual agreements.
