Dear Secretary Brillling:

Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (“RG&E” or “Company”) is hereby filing the following Renewable Portfolio Standard Statements to become effective October 1, 2005, in compliance with the New York Public Service Commission’s (“Commission’s”) Order Regarding Retail Renewable Portfolio Standard (“RPS”), issued and effective September 24, 2004 (the “Order”) in the above-referenced proceeding:

PSC No. 18 – Electricity, Schedule for Electric Street Lighting Service. RPS Statement No. 1
PSC No. 19 – Electricity, Schedule for Electric Service. RPS Statement No. 1

This filing is also made in accordance with Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H).

The Order established the RPS annual collection level for RG&E for 2006 at \$1,620,922. The surcharge amount for the period October 1, 2005 through September 31, 2006 is based on this 2006 annual collection level and equates to a \$0.0002 per kWh RPS charge on all customers kWh who currently pay the SBC charge.

Any over or under-collections will be trued up on an annual basis. RG&E will file annually to increase the RPS charge based on the annual collection level and the Order.

Per Ordering Clause 7 of the Order, the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of the changes proposed by this filing are waived.
