The Order directed utilities to allow a customer to select an anniversary date that is different than the one-year subsequent to when the customer began taking service under the net metering provision in order to cash-out excess net metering credits. Customers that have already exercised this option for those utilities that had such a policy in place are not afforded a second opportunity to revise their anniversary date. This option must be incorporated into the utilities' tariffs so that customers considering installation of generation that qualifies for net metering will be informed of the option's availability.

Requirements of Public Service Law Section 66 (12) (b) as to newspaper publication of the tariff revisions are waived pursuant to Ordering Clause 3 of the Order.
