Dear Secretary Brilling:

The enclosed tariff leaves, issued by Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E" or "the Company"), are being transmitted for filing in compliance with the New York State Public Service Commission Order ("Order"), issued and effective May 20, 2011 in the above-referenced proceeding. This filing is also made in accordance with Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) of the New York State Public Service Commission's ("PSC" or "Commission") Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H).

The tariffs are to become effective on August 1, 2011.

The Order approved the Company's plan to expand Mandatory Hourly Pricing to customers taking service in Service Classification Nos. 8 or 14 consistent with the phase-in schedule for customers to implement reactive pricing in Case 08-E-0751. The Company is filing changes to its tariffs in compliance with the Order.

The Company also identified and included three housekeeping changes to the draft tariff amendments in the Order. The first change is on Leaf 194.5, Price_{spotauc} is used in equation but Price_{spot} is used in the description, the description was changed to match the equation, Price_{spotauc}. The other two changes are on Leaf 243.1, the effective dates for phases 2 and 3 of the reactive charge were clarified to coordinate with the MHP expansion phase-in. Phase 2 now reads "Effective with the first full billing period on or after September 22, 2011" and Phase 3 was changed to "Effective with the first full billing period on or after September 22, 2012." The phase-in should be applicable beginning on September 22 in lieu of the October 1 date to make the schedules consistent.

Newspaper Publication

Requirements of Public Service Law Section 66 (12) (b) as to newspaper publication of the tariff revisions are waived pursuant to Ordering Clause 4 of the Order.
