The enclosed tariff leaves, issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid, are transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission ("Commission").

The purpose of this filing is to make minor clarifying/housekeeping revisions to the above leaves which were originally issued in compliance with Order of the Public Service Commission in Case No. 10-E-0050 issued January 24, 2011. The clarifying revisions included in this filing are:

1. Leaf No. 222, Rule 42.2 (ii) - Removal of the language, "in accordance with the terms of their individual contracts". This revision will more clearly state that all customers served under SC-11 and SC-12 are exempt from the Merchant Function Charge-Rule 42.
2. Leaf No. 263.2, Rule 57.1.2.1 - Removal of the language, "in accordance with the terms of their individual contracts". As per Item 1 above, this revision will more clearly state that all customers served under SC-11 and SC-12 are exempt from the Revenue Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") - Rule 57. These customers have the option of electing to participate in the RDM in accordance with the requirements in Rule 57.1.2.
3. Leaf No. 263.2, Rule 57.1.2.2 - Removal of the language (existing and additional) as it relates to the exemption of customers receiving Expansion Power from NYPA from the Revenue Decoupling Mechanism-Rule 57. This revision more clearly defines that all customers receiving NYPA Expansion power are exempt from Rule 57.

Because of the housekeeping/conforming nature of this filing, waiver of the statutory time requirements is requested for this filing to become effective on thirty days notice, on May 20, 2011.

Waiver of the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law regarding newspaper publication is also requested for this filing.

This filing is made in accordance with Appendix 7-H (electronic filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR, Appendix 7-H).
