Dear Secretary Brillling:

The attached leaf, issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (“Company”), is being transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission (“Commission”).

Second Revised Leaf No. 108

To P.S.C. No. 220 Electricity

Effective: August 1, 2010

The purpose of this filing is to revise the leaf issued on April 22, 2010 which proposed modifications to Rule 21.3.3 of the Retail Tariff P.S.C. No. 220 Electricity to allow the Company to implement the National Grid Connects Program (“Connects Program”).

The Connects Program is a new program the Company proposed to implement for the convenience and benefit of its residential customers. The Connects Program will allow a licensed electrician who is registered with the Company to make the permanent overhead connection between the Company’s overhead service lateral and the customer’s service entrance conductor.

Further revisions to this filing were requested by Staff of the Public Service Commission to more clearly define the applicability provisions of this program. Specifically this rule has been revised to more clearly define that this program is only applicable to “single phase, three wire, 200 amp or less, existing residential overhead service”.

As requested in the filing of April 22, 2010, waiver of the requirements of 16 NYCRR §720-8 of the Commission’s regulations as to newspaper publication is requested for the changes to this filing. The Company will inform licensed electricians of the qualifications necessary to participate in the Connects Program via the website and mailers discussed above. In addition, the Connects Program is described in the Company’s Specifications for Electrical Installations booklet, which is available upon request.
