Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E" or "the Company") hereby submits for filing the following enclosed tariff leaf in compliance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission ("PSC" or "Commission") and Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H).

PSC No. 19 – Electricity, Schedule for Electric Service  
Leaf No. 243, Revision 16

Effective March 1, 2010

This filing is being submitted in further compliance with the Commission's Order Adopting Terms and Conditions for Non-Bypassable and Variable Commodity Charges, in Case 09-E-0228, issued and effective September 28, 2009 ("Commodity Order") and consistent with tariff revisions that were approved by the Commission in Case 08-E-0751<sup>1</sup>. This filing consolidates revisions submitted in the aforementioned Cases. Tariff revisions were submitted to update the Transition Charge applicable to Standby customers to be effective on January 1, 2010 and subsequently approved in the Commodity Order. On October 22, 2009, RG&E was required to file tariffs in compliance with the Reactive Order to be effective on March 1, 2010. The proposed revisions herein reflect the consolidation of these filings to ensure that the correct rates approved by the Commodity Order become effective on January 1, 2010 with the correct rates that were filed in compliance with the Reactive Order.

The Company has discussed these revisions with PSC Staff.
