Statement of System Benefits Charge SBC-7

The revision to the Statement of System Benefit Charge reflects the Commission's approval to augment the System Benefit Charge ("SBC") as reflected in ordering clause No. 11 of the above Order. The rates reflected on SBC-7 reflect incremental additions to the previously calculated rates determined pursuant to the aforementioned Order and in collaboration with DPS Staff. In addition, based on discussion with Staff, the revisions to the above noted leaves extend the System Benefit Charge to all firm transportation customers taking service under Service Classification No. 11.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 12 of the above referenced Order, the requirements of 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of these amendments have been waived.
