These revisions to the tariff and System Benefits Charge Statement No. 7 are being filed in compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 12 in the Commission’s “Order Approving Certain Commercial and Industrial Customer Energy Efficiency Programs with Modifications” issued October 23, 2009 (“October 23rd Order”) in the aforementioned cases.

The purpose of the proposed revisions to the Company's tariff and the System Benefits Charge Statement No. 7 is to collect additional program funding for certain approved commercial and industrial energy efficiency programs as listed on Appendix 2, Table 6 of the October 23rd Order. Specifically, System Benefits Charge Statement No. 7 adds additional funding of \$2.65 million to cover certain commercial and industrial energy efficiency programs for the twelve-month period January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010.
