Purpose of the Filing

In compliance with Ordering Clause 4 of the September 22 Order, RG&E is filing tariff revisions to set forth provisions and rates for reactive charges. The tariffs reflect a three year phase-in of the reactive provisions as approved by the September 22 Order. Such rates will be applied to a customer’s bill if the customer’s metered demand is not less than the demand level established for each phase in any two of the previous twelve months.

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Newspaper Publication

In accordance with Ordering Clause 10 of the Order, the requirement of Section 66(12) (b) of the Public Service Law that requires newspaper publication of proposed tariff changes is waived.
