Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits for filing 6th Revised Leaf No. 112 reflecting revisions to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 4 – Gas ("Gas Tariff").

This leaf is issued December 2, 2009, to become effective January 1, 2010.

Reason for Filing

In its Order Approving Certain Commercial and Industrial Customer Energy Efficiency Programs with Modifications (the "Order"), issued and effective October 23, 2009, in the above-referenced cases, the Commission approved additional annual amounts be collected through the System Benefits Charge ("SBC"). The Order directed the Company to collect incremental gas SBC amounts over the three years beginning 2011 as follows: \$50,825, \$68,546, and \$10,007, to be collected in calendar years 2011, 2012, and 2013, respectively.

Summary of Proposed Changes

General Information Section 23 of the Gas Tariff has been revised to indicate the incremental amounts to be collected. Any over- or under-collections (differences in SBC collections from the target amount) for each calendar year through 2012 will be reconciled and reflected in the subsequent year's SBC. Any over- or under-collections of the SBC during 2013 will also be reconciled and credited to or collected from customers as directed by the Commission.


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Conclusion and Notice

In compliance with the Order, the Company is filing its tariff amendment on not less than 30 days' notice to become effective on January 1, 2010. On November 24, 2009, the Commission granted an extension until December 15, 2009, for the Company to file its updated Statement of System Benefits Charge, apart from its rate schedule, to become effective on January 1, 2010. The requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication were waived in ordering clause 12 of the Order.
