On June 22, 2009 an Order was issued in the above case directing further revisions to the Company's filing which contained amendments to Public Service Law Sections 66-l (Net Energy Metering for Residential, Farm Service and Non-Residential Wind Electric Generating Systems). On June 25, 2009 the Company complied with this directive and filed further revisions in compliance with this Order.

The above leaf is being further revised to comply with this Order. Specifically, Item F - Environmentally Advantageous Technologies, section (a) has been revised to correctly specify the limits for non-residential non-demand solar and wind technologies.

Waiver of the statutory requirements for this leaf to become effective on less than thirty day's notice is requested for this filing to be consistent to the requirements of the above Order.

Also, per Ordering Clause No. 4 of this Order, the requirements of §66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication are waived.
