Rochester Gas & Electric Corporation ("RG&E" or the "Company") hereby submits for filing the following enclosed tariff leaves in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 1 of the New York Public Service Commission's (the "Commission") Order Modifying and Authorizing Wind Net Metering Tariffs, Case No. 09-E-0297, issued and effective June 22, 2009 (the "Order") and Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H).

**Description of Tariff Revisions**

*Payments to Residential Customers*

The Company is revising its tariffs to conform the form of payment for residential customers to the form of payment for farm service customers. Residential customers will receive a cash payment for any excess generation that has accumulated on the customer's account at the end of a year.

*Metering Costs*

RG&E has revised its tariffs to state the responsibility of meter costs for customers with generators that are equal to or greater than 25kW in which the Company has determined a second meter to be necessary. The customer will be responsible for one-half of any interconnection costs, including costs for the second meter and installation costs.

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*Farm Service Definition*

RG&E has clarified the definition of an eligible farm service customer. The farm on which the wind generator is sited must also be the location of the customer's primary residence.

**Newspaper Publication**

In accordance with Ordering Paragraph 4, the requirement of § 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law regarding newspaper publication is waived.
