The proposed revisions are issued as of today for an effective date of June 20, 2009. In support of this request, Distribution states as follows:

## A. Purpose of Proposed Revision

The purpose of this tariff filing is to amend the language in the tariff to reflect the modified terminology adopted by the Public Service Commission arising out of the changes in

the Public Service Law related to the Energy Consumer Protection Act of 2002 (Ch. 686 of Laws of 2002). There are a few other changes to correct typographic errors and to clarify customer's rights related to deferred payment agreements.

## B. <u>Newspaper Publication</u>

The Company requests a waiver of the Commission's requirement under Public Service Law §66(12)(b) for newspaper publication of the above revision. The revision is largely non-substantive in customer effect, and therefore the expense of publication would not serve the public interest.

## C. <u>Conclusion</u>

For all of the foregoing reasons, Distribution respectfully requests that the proposed tariff revisions be approved for an effective date of June 20, 2009.
