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Tariff Revisions

The Commission determined in the Order that RG&E shall make adjustments to reconcile its Non-Bypassable Charges (“NBC”) during 2009 without waiting for reconciliation in 2010¹. In compliance with the Order, RG&E is submitting revisions to its tariffs and Transition Charge – Fixed (TCF) Statement to implement an interim adjustment as of June 1, 2009.

Each month thereafter the Company will examine the forecasted year-end difference between the NBC dollars the Company expects to collect and an updated forecast of NBC dollars. If the expected under- or over-collection exceeds \$10 million, an interim reconciliation adjustment will be applied to the NBC the following month. Any remaining reconciliation that is required for 2009 will be reflected in the calculation of the 2010 NBC.

Customers taking service under RG&E’s Fixed Price Option and ESCO Option with Supply Adjustment will not be subject to an interim reconciliation adjustment. Asset Sale Gain Account credits that the Company owes to customers will be used to mitigate the increase in NBC charges for them².

Newspaper Publication

In accordance with Ordering Paragraph 2, the requirements of § 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law regarding newspaper publication are waived.
