The revisions being made are housekeeping changes to the tariffs filed on March 2, 2009 (the "March filing"). First, a revision is being made to correct the periods for calculating the interim reconciliation adjustment. The March filing was submitted concurrently with a petition that provided more detailed support for the tariff revisions. The petition described the interim reconciliation adjustment that may be applied to the NBC on July 1, 2009 for the period ending May 31, 2009 and again on October 1, 2009 for the period ending August 31, 2009 for interim refunds or surcharges. The tariff leaf that was filed on March 2, 2009, incorrectly referenced the periods ending June 30 and September 30 for calculating the adjustments. Second, the March filing also inadvertently did not include the revisions to the individual service classifications that were made to the General Information section of the tariff. The revisions included in today's filing proposes conforming changes to the language that appears in each of the service classes to be consistent with the revisions that were proposed to the General Information section in the March filing.

After discussions with Department of Public Service Staff, the postponement Supplement is being filed to permit additional review of the filing. This Supplement proposes to postpone the effective date of the filed tariff leaves until June 26, 2009.
