Purpose of the Filing

The purpose of this filing is to revise Rule No. 53 – Standardized Interconnection Requirements (SIR) and Application Process for New Distributed Generators 2MW or Less Connected in Parallel to Utility Distribution Systems in compliance with the above order. Ordering Clause No. 3 of this order directed the Company to file tariff amendments that comply with the revised Standard Interconnection Requirements (SIR) to reflect the amendments to Public Service Law (PSL) §66-j which became effective September 12, 2010.
