Purpose of the Filing

The purpose of this filing is to revise Rule No. 53 – Standardized Interconnection Requirements (SIR) and Application Process for New Distributed Generators 2MW or Less Connected in Parallel to Utility Distribution Systems in compliance with the above order. Ordering Clause No. 3 of this order directed the Company to file tariff amendments that comply with the revised Standard Interconnection Requirements (SIR) to reflect the amendments to Public Service Law (PSL) §66-j which became effective September 12, 2010. These revisions to the SIR are directed to become effective on not less than one day's notice on January 1, 2011.

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 2 of this order, the requirements of §66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication are waived for this filing.
