Addendum No. 2 – Uniform Business Practices

To PSC No. 220 Electricity

Effective: January 10, 2011

Purpose of the Filing

On December 17, 2010, the Commission issued the above Order adopting revised Uniform Business Practices (UBP’s). In this Order, modifications were made to the existing UBP’s by implementing General Business Law §349-d which specifies requirements energy service companies (ESCOs) must comply with when marketing energy services, defined as natural gas or electricity, to residential customers and/or through door-to-door sales.

Ordering Clause No. 3 of the above order directed electric and gas utilities that have tariff provisions providing for retail access to file tariff amendments or addenda to incorporate the changes to the Uniform Business Practice revisions approved in this Order. These revisions are allowed to become effective on not less than one day’s notice, on or before January 10, 2011. Addendum No. 2 attached to this filing incorporates these revised rules as directed in this order. Also Leaf No. 209 is included with this filing to revise the reference to Addendum No. 2 and the issue date of the order to December 17, 2010.

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 4 of this order, the requirements of §66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication are waived for this filing.
