Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits for filing 9th Revised Leaf No. 112 reflecting revisions to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 4 – Gas ("Gas Tariff").

This leaf is issued January 27, 2011, to become effective February 1, 2011.

Reason for Filing

The Commission's <u>Order Continuing System Benefits Charge Funded Programs</u> (the "December 2010 Order"), issued and effective December 30, 2010, in the abovereferenced cases, approved an extension of System Benefits Charge ("SBC") III and authorized the transition of SBC energy resource acquisition programs to the Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard ("EEPS"). Table 6 of the December 2010 Order established incremental gas collections and transfers from the Company to NYSERDA of \$175,434 for 2013.

Summary of Proposed Changes

General Information Section 23 of the Gas Tariff has been revised to reflect the changes in SBC collections as directed by the December 2010 Order.

Conclusion and Notice

In compliance with the December 2010 Order, the Company is filing its tariff amendment on not less than 5 days' notice to become effective on February 1, 2011. The requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication were waived in Ordering Clause 1 of the December 2010 Order. Honorable Jaclyn A.
