## Reason for the Proposed Filing

The Commission's <u>Order Continuing System Benefits Charge Funded Programs</u> (the "December 2010 Order"), issued and effective December 30, 2010, in the above referenced cases, approved an extension of System Benefits Charge ("SBC") III and authorized the transition of SBC energy resource acquisition programs to the Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard ("EEPS"). Table 6 of the December 2010 Order establishes incremental gas collections and transfers from the Company to NYSERDA of \$1,605,025 for 2013.
