**RE: Case 03-G-0766 - Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation for Gas Service**

Dear Secretary Brillling:

The enclosed tariff leaves, issued by Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E" or "Company") are transmitted for filing in compliance with the New York Public Service Commission ("PSC" or "Commission") Order Adopting Provisions of Joint Proposals With Conditions, issued and effective May 20, 2004 (the "Order") in the above-referenced proceeding, and Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H). The leaves will become effective January 1, 2011.

Tenth Revised Leaf No. 70 to PSC No. 16 Gas  
Eighth Revised Leaf No. 127.17 to PSC No. 16 Gas

Section VII.2 of the Gas Rate Joint Proposal ("GRJP") approved per the Order directs RG&E to reset its Factor of Adjustment ("FA") on January 1 of each year if the actual lost and unaccounted for volumes from the immediately preceding three 12-month periods ending August 31 fall outside +/- 5% of the currently effective FA<sup>1</sup>. The FA will be reset based on the average of the actual lost and unaccounted for volumes from the immediately preceding three 12-month periods ending August 31, 2009. The GRJP further states that the FA will not be reset above 1.0175 or below 1.0100. The attached filing updates the FA per the terms of the GRJP

The Company respectfully requests that the requirement of § 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 for newspaper publication be waived because the FA is updated through the monthly Gas Supply Charge which appears on sales customers' bills. For customers served by an Energy Service Company ("ESCO"), the Company will communicate with the ESCOs directly to inform them of the revision.
