Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") is filing today with the Public Service Commission ("the Commission") further amendments to its Schedule for Gas Service, PSC No. 9 – Gas ("the Gas Tariff"). The changes to the Schedule are set forth in the attached tariff leaves, which bear a notation that the leaves are issued in compliance with the Commission's Order dated September 22, 2010 ("the September 2010 Order") in the subject case, and are being issued with an effective date of October 30, 2010.

The tariff leaves reflecting the revision are identified below:

Leaf 165, Revision 10 Superseding Revision 9 Leaf 181, Revision 11 Superseding Revision 10 Leaf 234, Revision 7 Superseding Revision 6 Leaf 243, Revision 8 Superseding Revision 7 Leaf 255, Revision 16 Superseding Revision 15

Summary of Proposed Changes

The tariff amendments being filed herewith represent housekeeping changes to tariff amendments filed on September 30, 2010 ("September 2010 Filing"), in the subject case and are

filed in compliance with the Commission's September 2010 Order. The changes being made to each of the listed tariff leaves are described below.

- <u>Leaf 165</u> Language in Section VII, (B), 1. (d) (i) and (ii) regarding revenue from new customers on the Oil to Gas Conversion Program is being removed since that circumstance no longer applies.
- <u>Leaf 181</u> The annual amount the Company is allowed to recover under the Oil to Gas Conversion Program should be \$1.465 million instead of \$1.65 million.
- <u>Leaf 234 and Leaf 243</u> Air conditioning rates, which were inadvertently not changed in the September 2010 Filing, are being changed. Although the air conditioning rate changes were not reflected in the September 2010 Filing, the revised air conditioning rates were properly reflected in the Company's billing system effective October 1, 2010, and no customer has been charged an incorrect rate.
- <u>Leaf 255</u> The Table of Contents, (G), has been amended to remove references to Daily Delivery Service and Daily Cashout Service, since these balancing services no longer exist.

Notices

The Company respectfully requests waiver of the Public Service Law requirement as to newspaper publication of the above-described tariff amendments, since the changes proposed are of a clerical nature and are being made in compliance with the September 2010 Order.

The Company is serving copies of this filing upon all parties to this proceeding.
