On August 30, 2010, the Company filed updated SBC Statements in accordance with the Commission’s Order Approving Three New Energy Portfolio Standard (EEPS) Programs And Enhancing Funding and Making Other Modifications For Other EEPS Programs, issued and effective June 24, 2010 (“EEPS Order”).

On September 26, 2010, the Company filed an updated electric SBC Statement to reflect the base component moving to the SBC Surcharge in accordance with the Joint Proposal that was approved by the Order.

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Today's filing updates the SBC rates filed in compliance with the Joint Proposal with the required collection of additional revenues stated in the EEPS Order.
