Effective: October 1, 2010.

Pursuant to the June Order, the Company is filing revisions to its statements to collect additional revenue through the existing System Benefits Charge ("SBC") for gas and electric customers.

The June Order approved the implementation of three new energy efficiency programs to be administered by Central Hudson and NYSERDA and also provides

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enhanced funding for fifteen existing EEPS programs. The June Order identifies additional collections required for each utility for the period October 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010 in Tables 6 and 14 of Appendix 2. The surcharges will be effective on October 1, 2010, and will apply to customer usage on and after that date.

Per Ordering Clause No. 12 of the June Order the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of the changes proposed by this filing is waived.
