Dear Acting Secretary Cohen:

Enclosed for filing with the New York State Public Service Commission (the "Commission") are revised schedule leaves issued by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") to the Company's Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity, applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

Tariff leaves reflecting the changes are identified below:

The leaves are issued to become effective on February 1, 2013.

Reason for Filing

This filing is being made pursuant to the Commission's Order Directing Tariff Filing (the "Order"), issued and effective November 29, 2012, in Case 12-E-0043, *Central Hudson Gas and Electric Corporation – Tariff Filing to Revise its Billing Provisions Applicable to Customers That are Both Net Metered and Subject to Hourly Pricing Provisions*.

Summary of Tariff Changes

As directed by the Order, the Company has described in its tariff its current practice of determining monthly charges/credits for supply for Full Service accounts served under Rider M and Retail Access accounts that would otherwise be served under Rider M on a mandatory basis. The charges/credits are determined for each hour in which electricity is either consumed or produced and then summed for the billing period.

As further directed by the Order, the Company has specified how supply and delivery credits will be calculated for farm service customers who are served under Rider M or would be served under Rider M if they purchased supply from the Company.

The Company has also made a housekeeping change on Leaf 251.1 to eliminate text about Rider Q – Power for Jobs Program, because that program expired on June 30, 2012.

Conclusion and Notice

Ordering Clause 2 of the Order indicated that the filing should be made by December 19, 2012, but the Commission, in its issuance of December 12, 2012, extended the filing deadline to January 28, 2013, at each utility's option. Pursuant to Ordering Clause 2 of the Order and the issuance of December 12, 2012, this filing has an effective date of February 1, 2013. Pursuant to Ordering Clause 3 of the Order, the requirement for newspaper publication has been waived.
