Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") hereby submits for filing the following tariff leaves proposing revisions to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – GAS (the "Gas Tariff"):

In addition, the Company is filing Supplement No. 44 to the Gas Tariff.

These leaves and supplement are issued October 31, 2012, to become effective November 1, 2012 in compliance with the Commission's Orders, issued and effective May 23, 2012 and October 18, 2012 ("October 2012 Order"), in Case No. 11-G-0543. Ordering Clause 4 of the October 2012 Order directed the Company to file the above leaves and supplement, on not less than one day's notice, to retain the provisions concerning the shut-down option and to retain the tariff provisions for temperature control customers.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 6 of the October 2012 Order, the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12) regarding newspaper publication of the amendments directed in Ordering Clause 4 are waived.
