Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits for filing  
Statement RDM-5 to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 4 – GAS ("Gas Tariff").  
This statement is issued November 21, 2012, to become effective December 1, 2012.

The purpose of this filing is to implement the reconciliation of the Company's gas  
revenue decoupling mechanism for the period November 1, 2011 through October 31,  
2012 ("Rate Year 3") in accordance with General Information Section No. 25, Revenue  
Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") Adjustment, of the Gas Tariff.

The Rate Year 3 cumulative net delivery revenue shortfalls for Group A and  
Group B<sup>1</sup> are \$2,374,367 and \$1,044,218, respectively, including interest. These  
amounts include the effect of Interim RDM Adjustments implemented April 1, 2012.  
Group-specific RDM surcharges have been determined to recover these net delivery  
revenue shortfalls over the twelve-month period commencing December 1, 2012.
