**RE: Case 11-E-0452, Green Jobs-Green New York On-bill Recovery**

Dear Secretary Brilling:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) is filing with the New York State Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) an amendment to its Schedule for Electricity, PSC No. 10 – Electricity, applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The tariff leaf identified below is issued to become effective on May 1, 2012.

**Reason for Filing**

On February 3, 2012, in conformance with NYSERDA’s decision that borrowers should not be billed by the utility for late payment charges on unpaid loan installment amounts, the Company filed a change to Rider H (“NYSERDA Loan Installment Program”) of P.S.C. No. 9 – Electricity to eliminate the provision regarding late payment charges on unpaid loan installment amounts. Subsequent to issuance of the filing, P.S.C. No. 9 – Electricity was superseded by electronic rate schedule, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (“P.S.C. No. 10”).

The Commission issued an Order, issued and effective April 19, 2012, in Case 11-E-0452 (the “Order”), approving the Company’s tariff filing and directing the Company to incorporate the amendment filed on February 3, 2012, into P.S.C. No. 10.<sup>1</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> By separate letter, the Company is issuing Supplement No. 93 to P.S.C. No. 9 – Electricity to cancel Eighth Revised Leaf No. 95 to P.S.C. No. 9. Supplement No. 93 has an effective date of April 30, 2012.

**Tariff Change**

As directed by Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Company is incorporating the approved tariff change into P.S.C. No. 10.

**Conclusion and Notice**

As directed by Ordering Clause 2, the tariff change to P.S.C. No. 10 is being filed on not less than one day's notice, to become effective on May 1, 2012. Ordering Clause 3 of the Order waived newspaper publication of this filing.
