On March 10, 2011 and June 21, 2011, the Company submitted proposed tariff modifications to its commodity rate mechanisms pursuant to the Commission’s Order establishing Rates for Electric Service issued on January 24, 2011. On July 15, 2011, the PSC issued its order approving the Company’s proposed tariff leaves to become effective January 1, 2012. A modification to the above leaf was inadvertently omitted from the above filings. Specifically, Special Provision D did not contain the reference to Rule 46- Electricity Supply Charge.

The requirements of Public Service Law §66(12) and 16NYCRR 720.8.1 regarding newspaper publication of these further revisions are waived for this filing.
